
COMMUNITY FISH FRIES DURING LENT – YOUR OPPORTUNITY TO "GO FISHING"

The Missions and Outreach Committee will be hosting 3 Fish Fries during this Lenten season:

- Friday, March 7th (First Friday of Lent)
- Friday, March 28th (Midway through Lent)
- Friday, April 18th (Good Friday)

As has been our custom, these Fish Fries will be free (although donations will be accepted). Such will ensure that anyone who wishes to eat can do so. Eat-in, takeout, and limited delivery (shut-ins, Food Pantry delivery clients) will be offered.

Concert featuring the works of Harry T. Burleigh



Friends,

We have much to celebrate at MLUMC! Many of you have met our church planter, Luis Soto, who has been working with the Hispanic population in Pittsburgh. Luis has the support of Church Council and the Outreach and Missions Committee, and recently began hosting Sunday services in Spanish at 6PM in Asbury Center. Once a month he plans to offer a meal as part of the service.



We would like to make sure the people attending these services feel welcomed as part of our church, and they <u>are</u> a part of our church, much like our other three services every Sunday. To that end, I am inviting various groups within MLUMC to help sponsor the monthly meals. The majority of these will be the first Sunday of the month, unless otherwise indicated. Sponsoring a meal means you would:

- 1. **Donate** \$200 from your budget or from a donation given by your members. Luis will use the money to plan and cook the meal. You do not need to worry about shopping or cooking.
- 2. **Attend** the meal and service on the designated Sunday. Don't speak Spanish? That's ok; a smile works in every language! In a pinch, Google Translate is awesome.
- 3. Assist with kitchen cleanup if needed.

Groups that sponsor a monthly meal could be a UWF group, a Sunday School class, a committee, the youth group, or a small group of family/friends who come together for this purpose.
